ANNUAL FUND-RAISING PROJECTS

Gitchee Gumees Brewfest:

The Superior Jaycees' Brewfest has grown into the largest Brewfest in the Northland. The Annual Gitchee Gumees Brewfest draws over 1,500 people to Wessman arena where they can sample more than 100 different beers from over 30 brewers.

Fair Booth/Grandstand Security:

We staff and operate a beverage booth and stage security at the Head of the Lakes Fair during the grandstand shows and races.

Annual Golf Outing:

Held in August our golf scramble at Nemadji continues to grow. The golf tournament is followed by a dinner and silent auction.

Pink the Rink:

The Superior Jaycees have teamed up with the men's and women's UWS hockey teams for an annual fundraiser for breast cancer. The UWS hockey teams will wear pink uniforms for one scheduled game. Following the game the jerseys are auctioned off. All profits go towards treating or defeating breast cancer.

SERVICE PROJECTS

Adopt-A-Highway:

The Jaycees sponsor a two-mile stretch of highway between Poplar and Wentworth.

Punt, Pass, and Kick:

Every September local children meet on the UWS Football field to participate in an NFL sponsored football skills competition. Winners advance to the regional event.

Sandbox Fill:

With the help of local businesses, the Jaycees fill children's sandboxes for them to enjoy at no cost.

Salvation Army Bell Ringing:

We ring bells twice a year, once in July and once near Christmas to raise money for our local Salvation Army.

Business After Five:

The Jaycees sponsor a Chamber of Commerce mixer to thank local businesses for their support throughout the year.
